

# **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

## Closures Along State Route 99 And Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along State Route (SR) 99 and Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Monday, Dec. 23, 2024, and will continue through Friday, March 14, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

## Closure And Detour Information:

#### **Multiple Closures:**

- Nighttime closure of the southbound SR 99 to Herndon Avenue off-ramp will occur from 9 p.m. on Monday, Dec. 23, to 6 a.m. on Wednesday, Dec. 25, 2024.
- Intermittent lane and shoulder closures along Golden State Boulevard between Herndon Avenue and SR-99 off-ramp starting Thursday, Dec. 26, 2024, through Friday, Mar. 14, 2025.

### Kathryn Avenue To Northbound SR 99 Detour

Traffic along Kathryn Avenue to northbound SR 99 will be detoured south on Golden State Boulevard, west on Veterans Boulevard, and onto the northbound SR 99 on-ramp.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.
