

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Lane Closures Along Northbound G Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a lane closure along northbound G Street, between Divisadero Street and Nielsen Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work will continue through Friday, Oct. 3, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closure along northbound G Street, between Divisadero Street and Nielsen Avenue in Fresno for utility work.

Work will continue through Friday, Oct. 3, 2025.

Northbound G Street Detour

Traffic going northbound on G Street will be detoured west on El Dorado

Street, north on Roeding Drive, east on Nielsen Avenue, then south on G Street

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Pedestrian access will be restricted in some areas.
