Lane Closures Along Northbound G Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along northbound G Street, between Nielsen Avenue and Divisadero Street in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Friday, Jan. 31, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closures along northbound G Street, between Nielsen Avenue and Divisadero Street in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Friday, Jan. 31, 2025.

Northbound G Street Detour:

Traffic going northbound on G Street will be detoured West on El Dorado Street, west on Whitesbridge Avenue, north on Roeding Drive, then east on Nielsen Avenue and onto G Street.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.



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
