



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Multiple Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard, East And Sunland Avenues In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple lane closures along Golden State boulevard, East and Sunland avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Wednesday, Jan. 8, through Tuesday, March 25, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Lane and shoulder closure along Golden State Boulevard, between Church and East avenues;
- Lane closure along East Avenue, north of Golden State Boulevard;
- Lane closure along Sunland Avenue, between Garret Avenue and the Jensen Avenue Overpass.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Wednesday, Jan. 8, through Tuesday, March 25, 2025.

East Avenue To Northbound Golden State Boulevard Detour

Traffic along East Avenue heading to northbound Golden State Boulevard will be detoured south on East Avenue, then east on Jensen Avenue and onto Golden State Boulevard.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.
