

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Intermittent Lane Closures Along Cornelia And Santa Ana Avenues In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along Cornelia and Santa Ana avenues in Fresno for sewer work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Monday, Jan. 20 through Friday, Feb. 7, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

- Lane closures along Cornelia Avenue, between Santa Ana and Shaw avenues;
- Lane closures along Santa Ana Avenue, between Cornelia Avenue and Golden State Boulevard.

Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Monday, Jan. 20 through Friday, Feb. 7, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all property owners.





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
