Night Work Near Road 26 In Madera County

Madera County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces night work along the high-speed rail corridor near Road 26, between the BNSF railroad tracks and Club Drive in Madera County to place pre-cast concrete girders at the Road 26 Grade Separation. Work is scheduled from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. as required by BNSF.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Night work along the high-speed rail corridor, between the BNSF railroad tracks and Club Drive in Madera County to place pre-cast concrete girders at the Road 26 Grade Separation.

Work is scheduled from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. on the following dates:

Lighting and noise levels will be monitored and maintained at

required levels following Cal/OSHA standards and requirements.
