



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Multiple Closures Along Shaw Avenue And Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along Shaw Avenue and Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for roadwork. Work will occur starting 9 p.m. on Monday, Jan. 6, until 6 a.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 7, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Lane closures along Shaw Avenue between Forestiere Avenue and El Capitan Avenue;
- Full road closure along Shaw Avenue between Forestiere Avenue and Golden State Boulevard;
- Lane closure along Golden State Boulevard, between Shaw and Cornelia avenues.

Work will occur starting 9 p.m. on Monday, Jan. 6, until 6 a.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 7, 2025. This schedule is subject to change.

Westbound Shaw Avenue Detour

Traffic going westbound along Shaw Avenue will be detoured south on Golden State Boulevard, west on Ashlan Avenue, then north on Polk Avenue to Shaw Avenue.

Eastbound Shaw Avenue Detour

Traffic going eastbound along Shaw Avenue will be detoured south on Polk Avenue, east on Ashlan Avenue, then north on Golden State Boulevard to Shaw Avenue.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.
