Road Closure Along Weber Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a road closure along Weber Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled to begin Wednesday, Jan. 29 and will continue through Wednesday, March 5, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Road closure along Weber Avenue between Herndon and Elgin avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled to begin Wednesday, Jan. 29, through Wednesday, March 5, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to residents and businesses will be maintained.
