

## **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

## Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along Malaga, East, American, Cedar And Nebraska Avenues In Fresno County

Fresno County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Malaga, East, American, Cedar and Nebraska avenues in Fresno County to transport embankment material to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled from 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Friday, February 7 through Friday, March 7, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

## Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along Malaga, East, American, Cedar and Nebraska Avenues in Fresno County to transport embankment material. Hauling is scheduled from 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Friday, February 7 through Friday, March 7, 2025.

## **Haul Route**

Material will be hauled from Malaga Avenue, south on East Avenue, east on American Avenue, then south on Cedar Avenue and east on Nebraska Avenue to a highspeed rail construction site.
