Road Closure Along Mono Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a permanent road closure along Mono Street, between G and H streets in Fresno. Cesar Chavez Boulevard is now open to traffic. Closure will go into effect on Tuesday, March 10, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Permanent road closure Mono Street, between G and H streets in Fresno.

Cesar Chavez Boulevard is now open to traffic.

Closure will go into effect on Tuesday, March 10, 2026.


Mono Street Eastbound Detour

Eastbound traffic along on Mono Street will be detoured south on F Street, east on Cesar Chavez Boulevard, then north on H Street to Mono Street.

Mono Street Westbound Detour

Westbound traffic along Mono Street will be detoured south on H Street, west on Cesar Chavez Boulevard, north on F Street to Mono Street.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all business and residents will be maintained.
