Multiple Closures Along California Avenue, Railroad Avenue, And G Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along California Avenue, Railroad Avenue, and G Street in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Friday, Dec. 5 through Thursday, Dec. 18, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

- Road closure along California Avenue between G Street and Railroad Avenue;
- Road closure along Railroad between California and Lorena avenues;
- Road closure along California Avenue between Cherry and Van Ness avenues;

 Road closure along Cherry Avenue between Woodward and California avenues

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Friday, Dec. 5 through Thursday, Dec. 18, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.





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
