

## **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

## Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along 5 ½ And Niles Avenues In Kings County

**Kings County, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts at the intersection of 5 ½ and Niles avenues in Kings County. This work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Monday, July 7 and Tuesday, July 8, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

## Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts at the intersection of 5  $\,\%$  and Niles avenues in Kings County.

This work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Monday, July 7 and Tuesday, July 8, 2025.

Flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and residents. Drivers may experience delays.
