Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along State Route 43 In Fresno County

Fresno County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along State Route (SR) 43, between Davis Avenue and a private access road south of Cole Slough in Fresno County for ongoing work on a high-speed rail structure. Work is scheduled intermittently from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Monday, Dec. 1, 2025, through Saturday, Jan. 31, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along SR 43, between Davis Avenue and a private access road south of Cole Slough in Fresno County for ongoing work on a high-speed rail structure.

Work is scheduled intermittently from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Monday, Dec. 1, 2025, through Saturday, Jan. 31, 2026.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all property and business owners in the area.
