

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Multiple Closures Along Golden State Boulevard And Kathryn Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along Golden State Boulevard and Kathryn Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Oct. 27 through Friday, Nov. 7, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Mulitple Closures:

- Intermittent lane closures along Golden State Boulevard, north of Herndon Avenue;
- Intermittent lane closures along Kathryn Avenue, west of Golden State Boulevard.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Oct. 27 through Friday, Nov. 7, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.
