Multiple Closures Along H, Fresno And G Streets In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along H, Fresno and G Streets in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Thursday, July 24 through Friday, Sept. 19, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Multiple Closures:

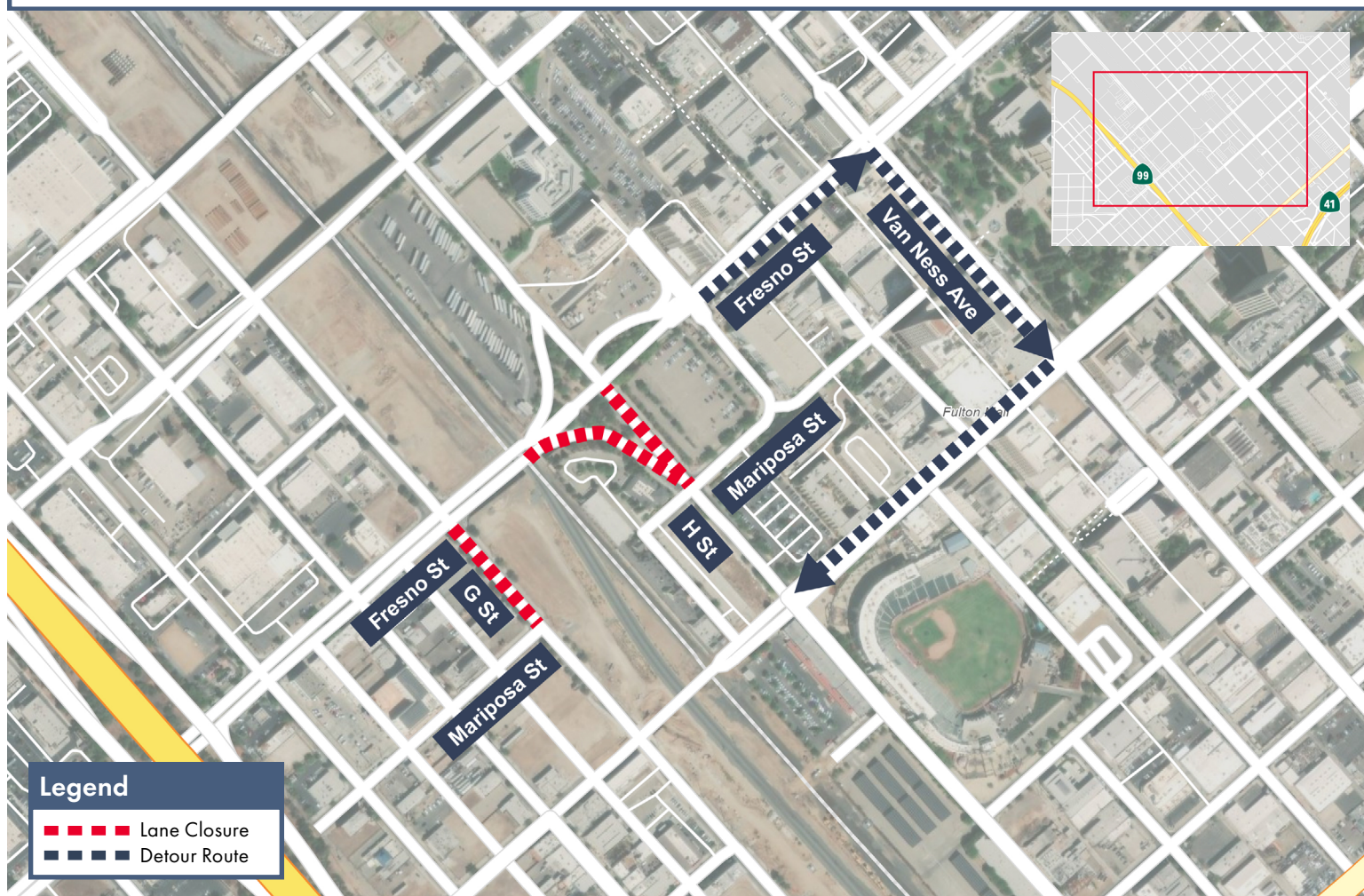
- Intermittent lane closure along H Street between Fresno and Mariposa streets;
- Ramp closure along eastbound Fresno Street interchange onto H Street;
- Lane closure along G Street between Fresno and Mariposa streets.

Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Thursday, July 24 through Friday, Sept. 19, 2025.

Fresno Street To H Street Detour

Traffic going eastbound along Fresno Street will be detoured south on Van Ness Avenue, then west on Tulare Street to H Street.

Flaggers and signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all property and business owners.



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
