Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along Lacey Boulevard In Kings County

Kings County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent lane closures along Lacey Boulevard, between State Route (SR) 43 and Seventh Avenue in Kings County for work at the Hanford Viaduct. Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Thursday, Oct. 30 through Saturday, Nov. 15, 2025.

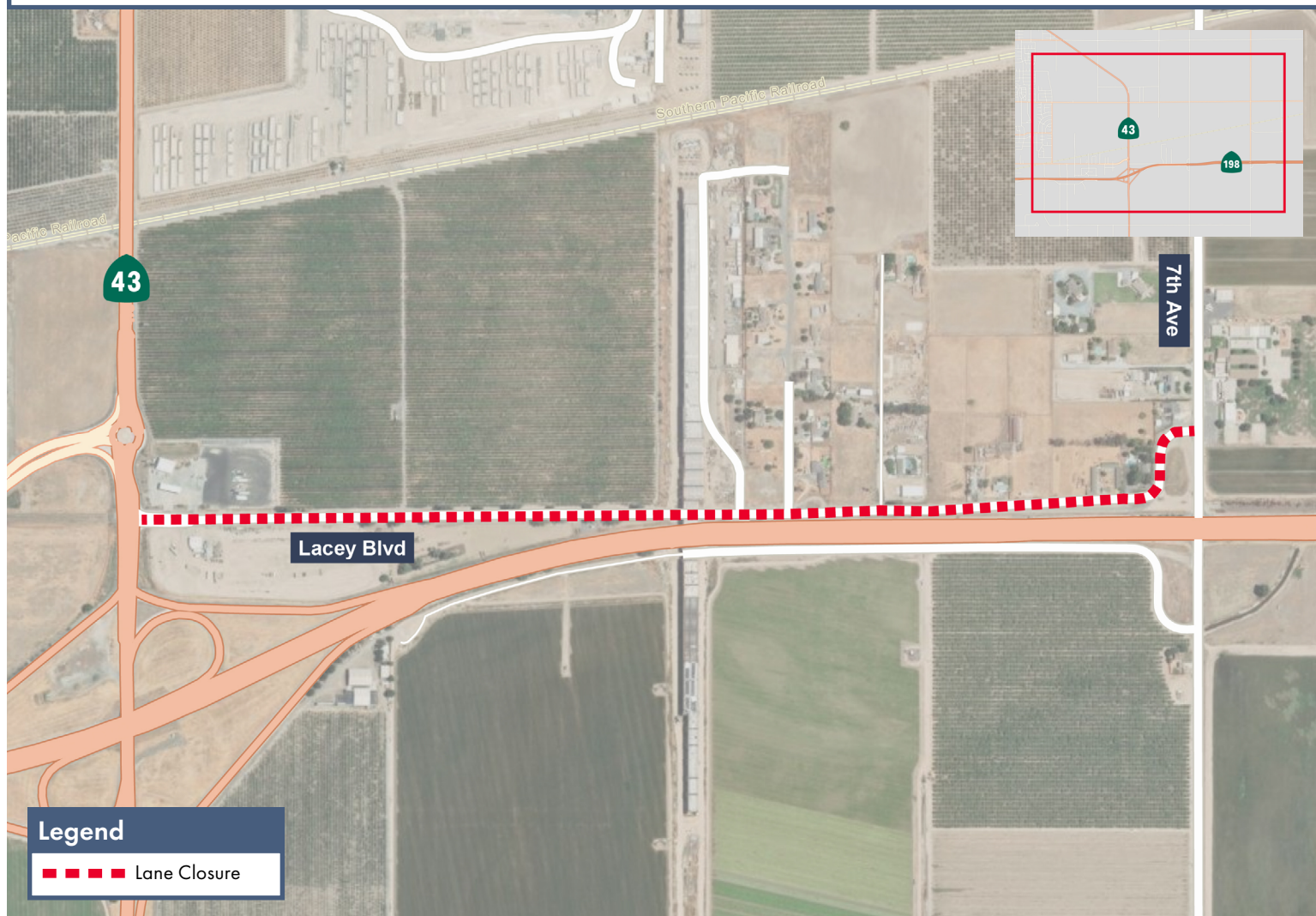
This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along Lacey Boulevard, between SR 43 and Seventh Avenue in Kings County for ongoing work at the Hanford Viaduct.

Flaggers and signage will be in place to direct traffic. Drivers may experience delays.

Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Thursday, Oct. 30 through Saturday, Nov. 15, 2025.



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
