

# **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

# Hauling Along State Route 43, 198, Hanford Armona Road, And 7th Avenue In Fresno And Kings County

Fresno and Kings County, Calif. –The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces hauling along State Route (SR) 43, SR 198, Hanford Armona Road and 7th Avenue in Fresno and Kings counties to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Friday, Aug. 29 through Tuesday, Sept. 2, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

## Closure And Detour Information:

Hauling along SR 43, SR 198, Hanford Armona Road and 7th Avenue in Fresno and Kings counties to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site.

Work is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Friday, Aug. 29 through Tuesday, Sept. 2, 2025.

Materials will be transported south on SR 43, east on SR 198, south on 7th Avenue, then west on Hanford Armona Road to a high-speed rail construction site.
