Lane Closure Along Cornelia And Weber Avenues In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a lane closure along Cornelia and Weber avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Monday, Sept. 29, 2025.

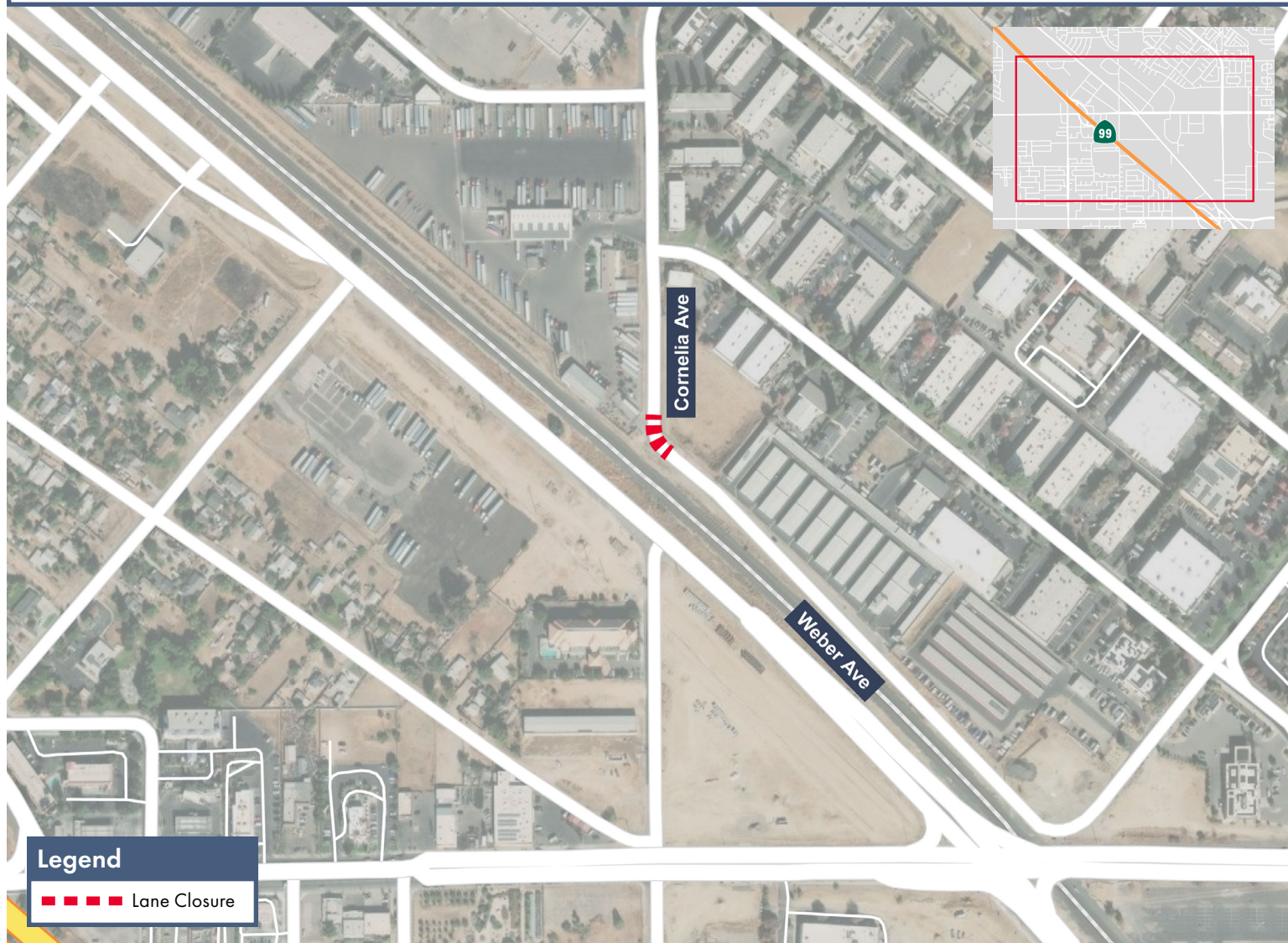
This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Traffic Shift, Closure, and Detour Information (detour on back page):

Lane closure along Cornelia and Weber avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Monday, Sept. 29, 2025.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access to driveways will be maintained for all property owners.



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
