## Lane Closure Along Fresno Street In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a lane closure along Fresno Street, between G and H streets in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Thursday, Sep. 4 through Friday, Sep. 5, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

## Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closure along Fresno Street between G and H streets in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Thursday, Sep. 4 through Friday, Sep. 5, 2025.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Pedestrian will be restricted in some areas. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.
