Lane Closures Along Golden State Boulevard At Mckinley Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along Golden State Boulevard McKinley Avenue in Fresno for K-Rail installation. Work is scheduled to continue through Wednesday, Sept. 17, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closures along Golden State Boulevard McKinley Avenue in Fresno for K-Rail installation. Work is scheduled to continue through Wednesday, Sept. 17, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.
