

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Road Closure Along Weber Avenue Cul-De-Sac In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a road closure along the Weber Avenue cul-de-sac, behind the Marketplace at El Paseo shopping center in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 6:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Friday, Oct. 17, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Road closure along the Weber Avenue cul-de-sac, behind the Marketplace at El Paseo shopping center in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 6:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Friday, Oct. 17, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all businesses and residents in the area.
