



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Material Haul Along Avenue 56 In Tulare County

Tulare County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Avenue 120, Road 264, Avenue 95, Road 192, and Avenue 56 in Tulare County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Wednesday, Sept. 17 through Wednesday, Oct. 29, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along Avenue 120, Road 264, Avenue 95, Road 192, and Avenue 56 in Tulare County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site.

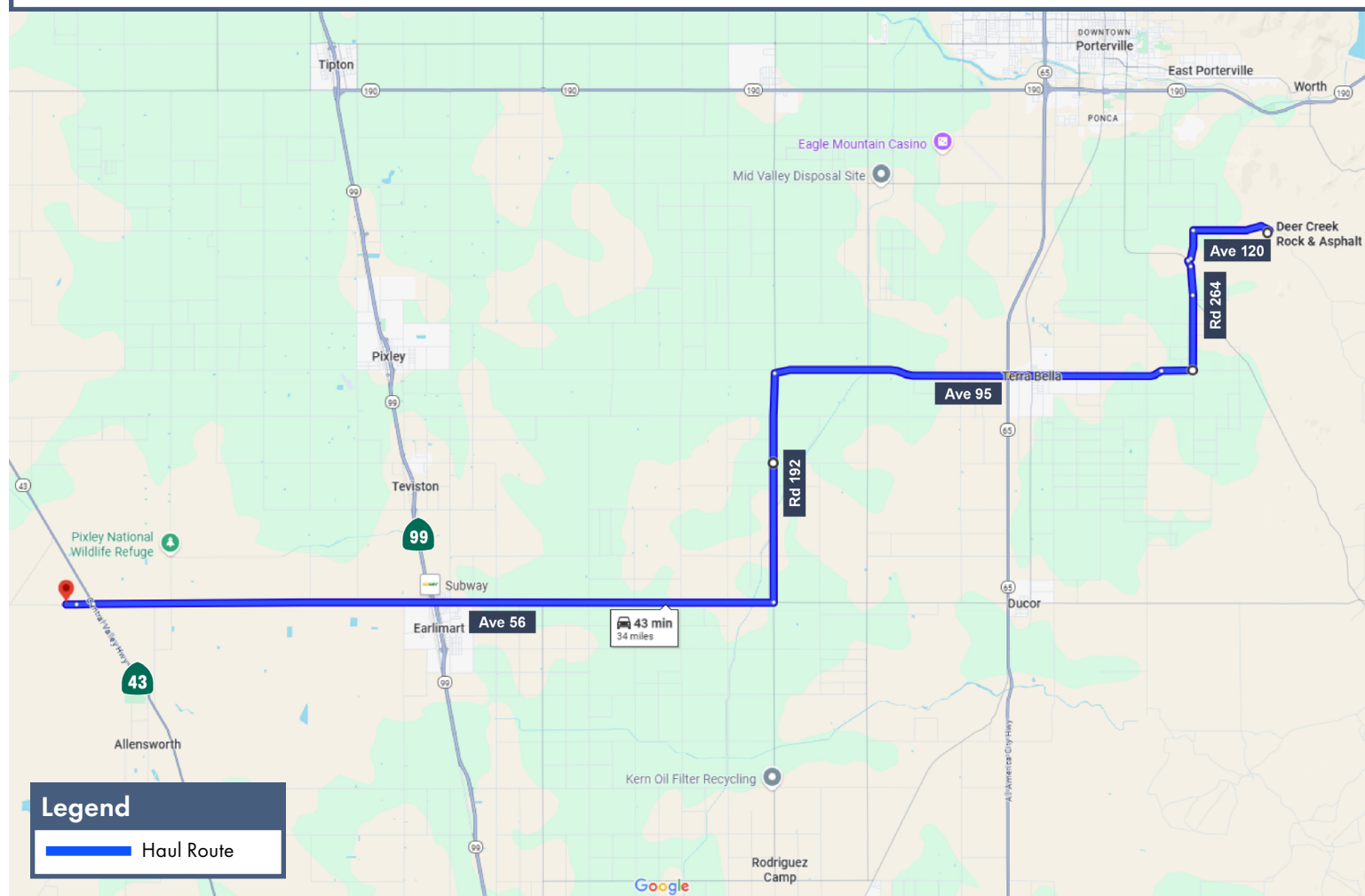
Hauling is scheduled from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Wednesday, Sept. 17 through Wednesday, Oct. 29, 2025.
