## Lane Closures Along Barstow Avenue And Golden State Boulevard In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along Barstow Avenue and Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for road work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Sept. 29 through Friday, Oct. 3, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

## Closure And Detour Information:

## **Multiple Closures:**

- Lane closure along Barstow Avenue between Golden State Boulevard and San Madele Avenue;
- Lane closures along the new Golden State Boulevard between Barstow Avenue and Veterans Boulevard.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Sept. 29 through Friday, Oct. 3, 2025.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and property owners.
