## Lane Closure Along The Median Of Cornelia Avenue In Fresno

**Fresno, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a lane closure along the median of Cornelia Avenue between Shaw and Santa Ana avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday, Oct. 2 and Friday, Oct. 3, 2025.

*This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.*

### Traffic Shift, Closure, and Detour Information (detour on back page):

Lane closure along the median of Cornelia Avenue between Shaw and Santa Ana avenues in Fresno for utility work.

**Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to driveways will be maintained for all property owners.**
