## Lane Closure Along The Median Of Cornelia Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a lane closure along the median of Cornelia Avenue between Shaw and Santa Ana avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday, Oct. 2 and Friday, Oct. 3, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

## Traffic Shift, Closure, and Detour Information (detour on back page):

Lane closure along the median of Cornelia Avenue between Shaw and Santa Ana avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to driveways will be maintained for all property owners.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Thursday, Oct. 2 and Friday, Oct. 3, 2025.
