

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Multiple Closures Along H, Mariposa, And Fresno Streets In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along H, Mariposa, and Fresno streets in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Wednesday, Oct. 29, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Intermittent lane closure along H Street between Tuolumne and Mariposa streets;
- Intermittent lane closures along Mariposa Street at H Street;
- Lane closure along Fresno Street at Broadway Street;
- Access road closure along the Fresno Street to H Street interchange.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Wednesday, Oct. 29, 2025.

Fresno Street To H Street Detour

Traffic along westbound Fresno Street will be detoured south on Broadway Street, then west on Mariposa Street to H Street.

Flaggers and signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained. Pedestrian access will be restricted in some area.
