Multiple Closures Along Thorne Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along Thorne Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Sept. 15 through Friday, Sept. 26, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.


Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Closures:

- Intermittent road closures long Thorne Avenue, between Belmont and Napa avenues;
- Intermittent lane closures along Thorne Avenue, between Voorman and Napa avenues;

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Sept. 15 through Friday, Sept. 26, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.
