

## **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

## Hauling Along Grangeville Boulevard, State Route 43, Jackson Avenue, Seventh Avenue, And Jersey Avenue In Kings County

**Kings County, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Grangeville Boulevard, State Route (SR) 43, Jackson Avenue, Seventh Avenue and Jersey Avenue in Kings County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled intermittently between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. starting Friday, Oct. 31 through Wednesday, Nov. 5, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

## Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along Grangeville Boulevard, SR 43, Jackson Avenue, Seventh Avenue and Jersey Avenue in Kings County to transport material to a high-speed rail construction site.

Hauling is scheduled intermittently between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. starting Friday, Oct. 31 through Wednesday, Nov. 5, 2025.

## **Haul Route**

Materials will be transported west on Grangeville Boulevard, south on SR 43, east on Jackson Avenue, south on Seventh Avenue, then west on Jersey Avenue to a high-speed rail construction site.
