



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## Hauling Along State Route 43 And Excelsior Avenue In Fresno And Kings Counties

**Fresno and Kings Counties, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along State Route (SR) 43 between Davis and Excelsior avenues in Fresno and Kings Counties to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled intermittently from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Monday, March 23 through Wednesday, March 25, 2026.

*This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.*

### Closure And Detour Information:


Intermittent traffic impacts along SR 43 between Davis and Excelsior avenues in Fresno and Kings Counties to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site.

**Work is scheduled to begin Monday, March 23 through Wednesday, March 25, 2026.**

#### Haul Route

Materials will be hauled from a high-speed rail construction site at Davis Avenue, south on SR 43, then east on Excelsior Avenue to a high-speed rail construction site.

**Haul routes are subject to change. Drivers are to proceed with caution.**
