## Intermittent Lane Closures Along H Street In Fresno

**Fresno, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along H Street, between Belmont Avenue and Divisadero Street in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Sunday, Jan. 11 through Monday, Feb. 23, 2026.

**This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.**

### Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along H Street between Belmont Avenue and Divisadero Street in Fresno for utility work.

**Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Sunday, Jan. 11 through Monday, Feb. 23, 2026.**

#### Southbound H Street Truck Detour

Traffic going southbound on H Street from Palm Avenue will be detoured east on Belmont Avenue, south on Blackstone Avenue, then west on Divisadero Street to H Street.

#### Northbound H Street To Northbound Palm Avenue Detour

Traffic along H Street to northbound Palm Avenue will be detoured east on Divisadero Street, north on Blackstone Avenue, then west on Belmont Avenue to Palm Avenue.

**Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Pedestrian access will be restricted in some areas. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.**



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
