

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Lane Closures Along Herndon Avenue And Riverside Drive In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along Herndon Avenue and Riverside Drive in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Wednesday, Nov. 26, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Lane Closures:

- Lane closures along Riverside Drive, between Palo Alto and Herndon avenues;
- Lane closures along Herndon Avenue, between Weber and Hayes avenues.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Wednesday, Nov. 26, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all businesses and residents.
