Intermittent Lane Closures Along Jensen Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along Jensen Avenue in Fresno for road work. Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting on Wednesday, Oct. 22 through Monday, Nov. 4, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along Jensen Avenue between Golden State Boulevard and Pullman Street in Fresno for road work.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and residents.

Work is scheduled from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting on Wednesday, Oct. 22 through Monday, Nov. 4, 2025.
