## Intermittent Lane Closures Along Kathryn Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along Kathryn Avenue at Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for road work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Nov. 3, through Friday, Nov. 7, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

## **Closure And Detour Information:**

Intermittent lane closures along Kathyrn Avenue at Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for road work.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Nov. 3, through Friday, Nov. 7, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all property owners and local businesses.
