Lane Closures Along Orange Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along Orange Avenue, between Laurite Avenue and Pullman Street in Fresno for utility work. Work will continue through Monday, Oct. 13. 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closures along Orange Avenue between Laurite Avenue and Pullman Street in Fresno for utility work.

Work will continue through Monday, Oct. 13, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all businesses and residents.
