

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Lane Closures Along Santa Ana Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces lane closures along Santa Ana Avenue, between Golden State Boulevard and Cornelia Avenue in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Tuesday, Oct. 7 through Friday, Nov. 14, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Lane closure along Santa Ana Avenue, between Golden State Boulevard and Cornelia Avenue in Fresno for utility work.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to businesses and residents will be maintained.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Tuesday, Oct. 7 through Friday, Nov. 14, 2025.
