## Intermittent Lane Closures Along West And Weber Avenues In Fresno

**Fresno, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple lane closures along West and Weber avenues in Fresno for k-rail removal. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Friday, Nov. 28, 2025.

*This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.*

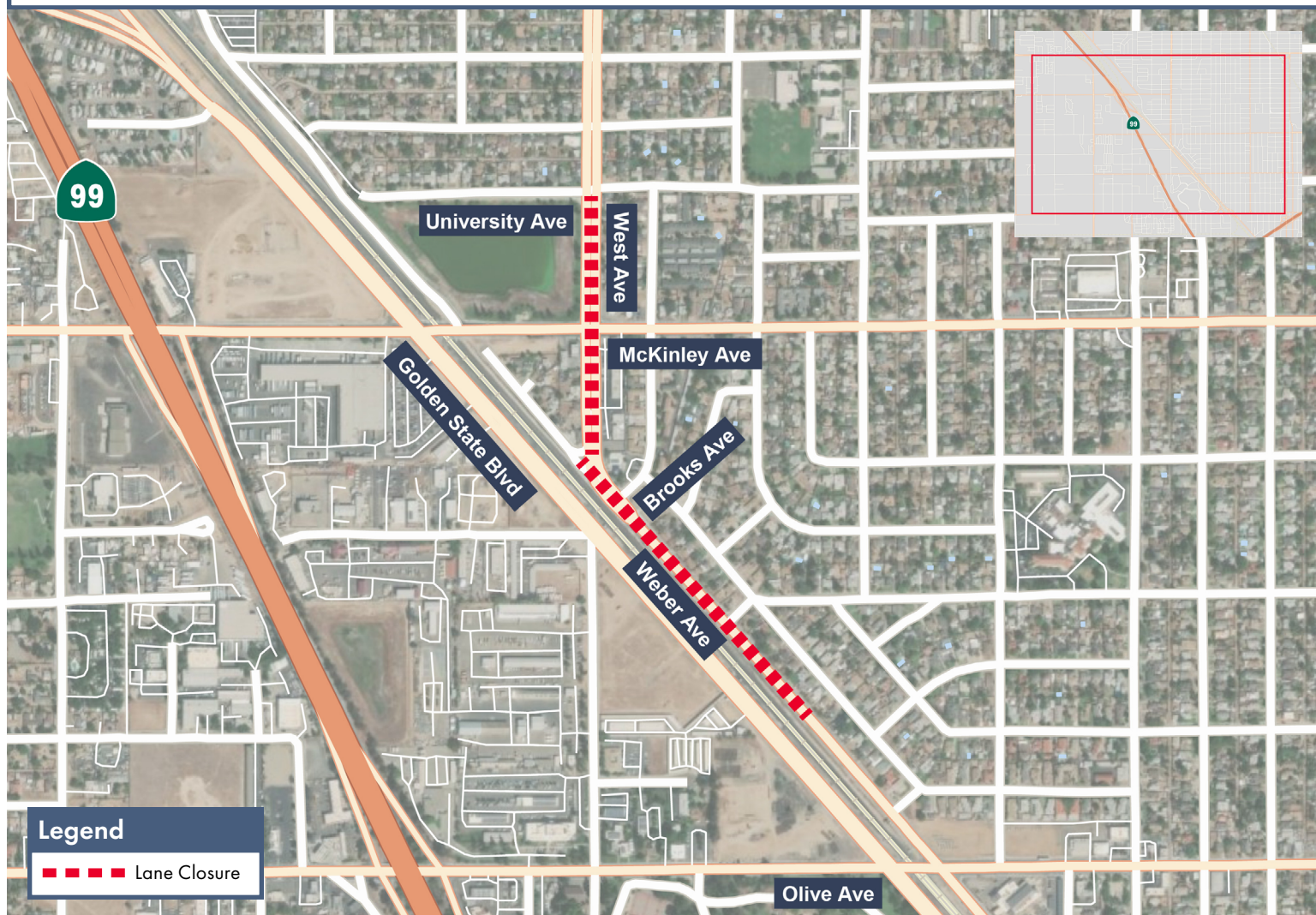
### Closure And Detour Information:

#### Multiple Lane Closures:

- Lane closures along West Avenue between University and Brooks avenues;
- Lane closures along Weber Avenue between Brooks and Olive avenues.

**Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Friday, Nov. 28, 2025.**

**Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Pedestrian access will be restricted in some areas. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.**



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
