



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Hauling Along Clarkson Avenue, State Route 43 And Avenue 144 In Fresno And Kings Counties

Fresno And Kings Counties, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Clarkson Avenue, State Route (SR) 43 and Avenue 144 in Fresno and Kings counties to transport precast deck panels to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling will be intermittent between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. starting Monday, Nov. 3 through Friday, Nov. 14, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

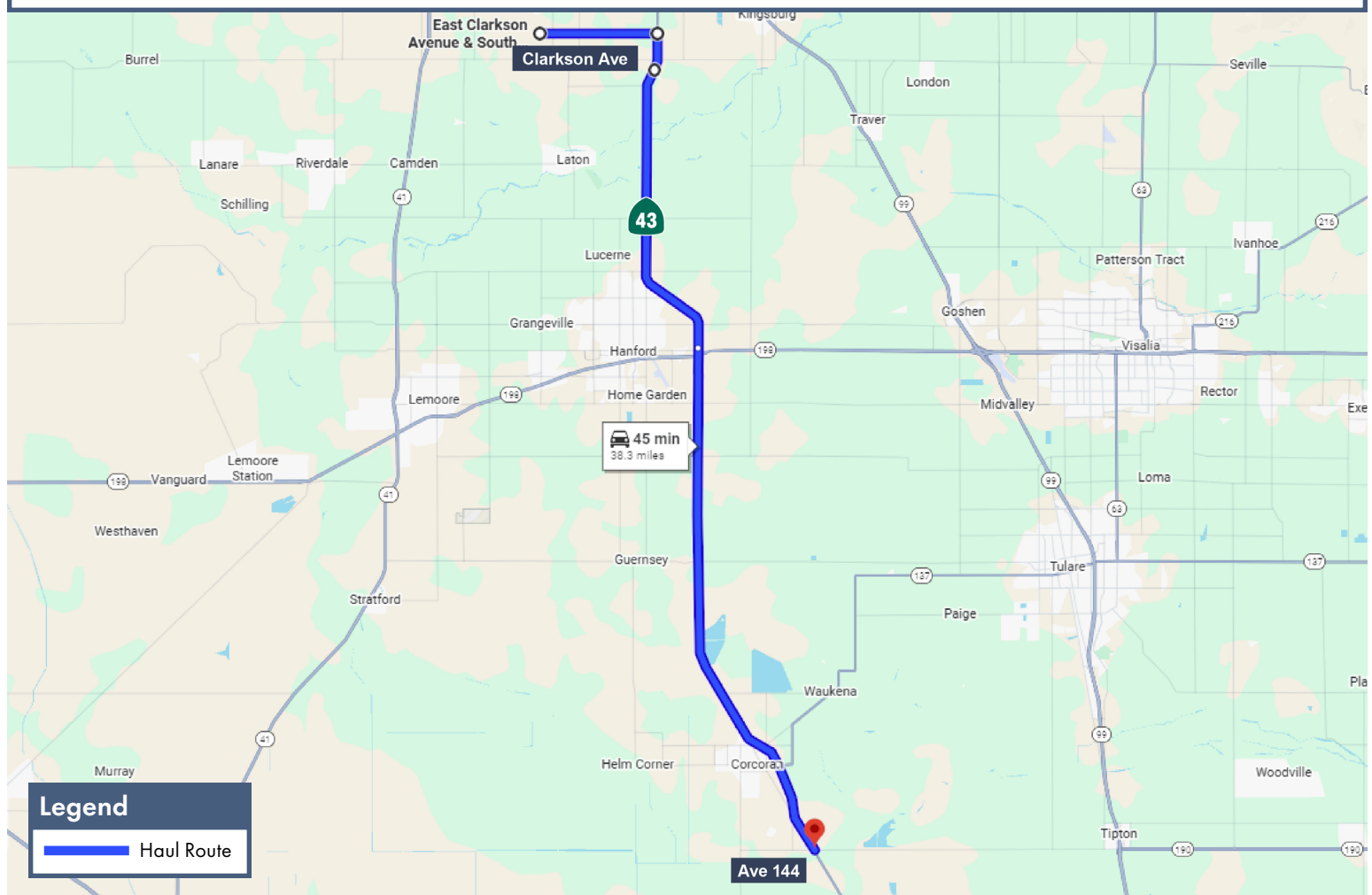
