

## **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

## Hauling Along Davis, Fowler And Manning Avenues In Fresno County

Fresno County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Davis, Fowler and Manning avenues in Fresno County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled intermittently between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. starting Monday, Nov. 24 through Sunday, Nov. 30, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

## Closure And Detour Information (larger map on back page):

Intermittent traffic impacts along Davis, Fowler and Manning avenues in Fresno County to transport material to a high-speed rail construction site.

Hauling is scheduled intermittently between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m.

## **Haul Route**

Materials will be transported west on Davis Avenue, north on Fowler Avenue, then west on Manning Avenue to a high-speed rail construction site.
