Intermittent Lane Closures Along Elder Avenue In Kings County

Kings County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent lane closures along Elder Avenue, between 8 ½ and 7th avenues in Kings County for utility work. Work is scheduled from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Wednesday, Nov. 12 through Friday, Nov. 21, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent lane closures along Elder Avenue, between 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ and 7th avenues in Kings County for work on a high-speed rail structure.

Work is scheduled from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Wednesday, Nov. 12 through Friday, Nov. 21, 2025.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all residents and property owners.
