

## **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

## Hauling Along Grangeville Boulevard, State Route 43, And Avenue 112 In Kings County

Kings County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Grangeville Boulevard, State Route (SR) 43 and Avenue 112 in Kings County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled intermittently between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. starting Thursday, Nov. 20 through Wednesday, Nov. 26, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

## **Closure And Detour Information:**

Hauling along Grangeville Boulevard, SR 43 and Avenue 112 in Kings County to transport material to a high-speed rail construction site.

Hauling is scheduled intermittently between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. starting Thursday, Nov. 20 through Wednesday, Nov. 26, 2025.

Materials will be transported west on Grangeville Boulevard, south on SR 43, then west on Avenue 112 to a high-speed rail construction site.
