

# **CONSTRUCTION ALERT**

# Road Closures At Poplar Avenue/Avenue 144 In Tulare County

**Tulare County, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces a daytime road closure along Poplar Avenue/Avenue 144 between State Route (SR) 43 and Fourth Avenue in Tulare County for ongoing work at the Tule River Viaduct. Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Monday, Dec. 1 and Tuesday, Dec. 2, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

## **Closure And Detour Information:**

Road closure along Poplar Avenue/Avenue 144 between SR 43 and Fourth Avenue in Tulare County for ongoing work at the Tule River Viaduct.

Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Monday, Dec. 1 and Tuesday, Dec. 2, 2025.

#### Westbound Poplar Avenue/Avenue 144 Detour

Traffic going westbound on Poplar Avenue / Avenue 144 will be detoured north on SR 43, west on Sante Fe Avenue, south on Fourth Avenue, then west onto Quebec/Poplar Avenue.

### Eastbound Poplar Avenue/Avenue 144 Detour

Traffic going eastbound on Quebec/Poplar Avenue will be detoured north on Fourth Avenue, east on Santa Fe Avenue, south on SR 43, then east on Poplar Avenue/Avenue 144.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic.
