Lane Closures Along Herndon Avenue And State Route 99 Herndon Avenue Off-Ramp In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple closures along Herndon Avenue and State Route 99 Herndon Avenue off-ramp in Fresno for utility and roadway work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 a.m. starting Monday, Dec. 29, 2025 through Friday, Jan. 30, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Lane Closures:

- Intermittent lane closures along Herndon Avenue between Parkway and Riverside Drive;
- Intermittent lane closures on the northbound State Route 99 to Herndon Avenue off-ramp.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 a.m. starting Monday, Dec. 29, 2025 through Friday, Jan. 30, 2026.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.
