Intermittent Lane Closures Along Kathryn Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces intermittent lane closures along Kathryn Avenue, near Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for road work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Wednesday, January 7, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent Lane closures along Kathryn Avenue, near Golden State Boulevard in Fresno for road work.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all property owners and local businesses.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Wednesday, Jan. 7, 2026.



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
