



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Intermittent Lane Closures Along West And Weber Avenues In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces multiple lane closures along West and Weber avenues in Fresno for K-rail removal. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Friday, Jan. 9, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

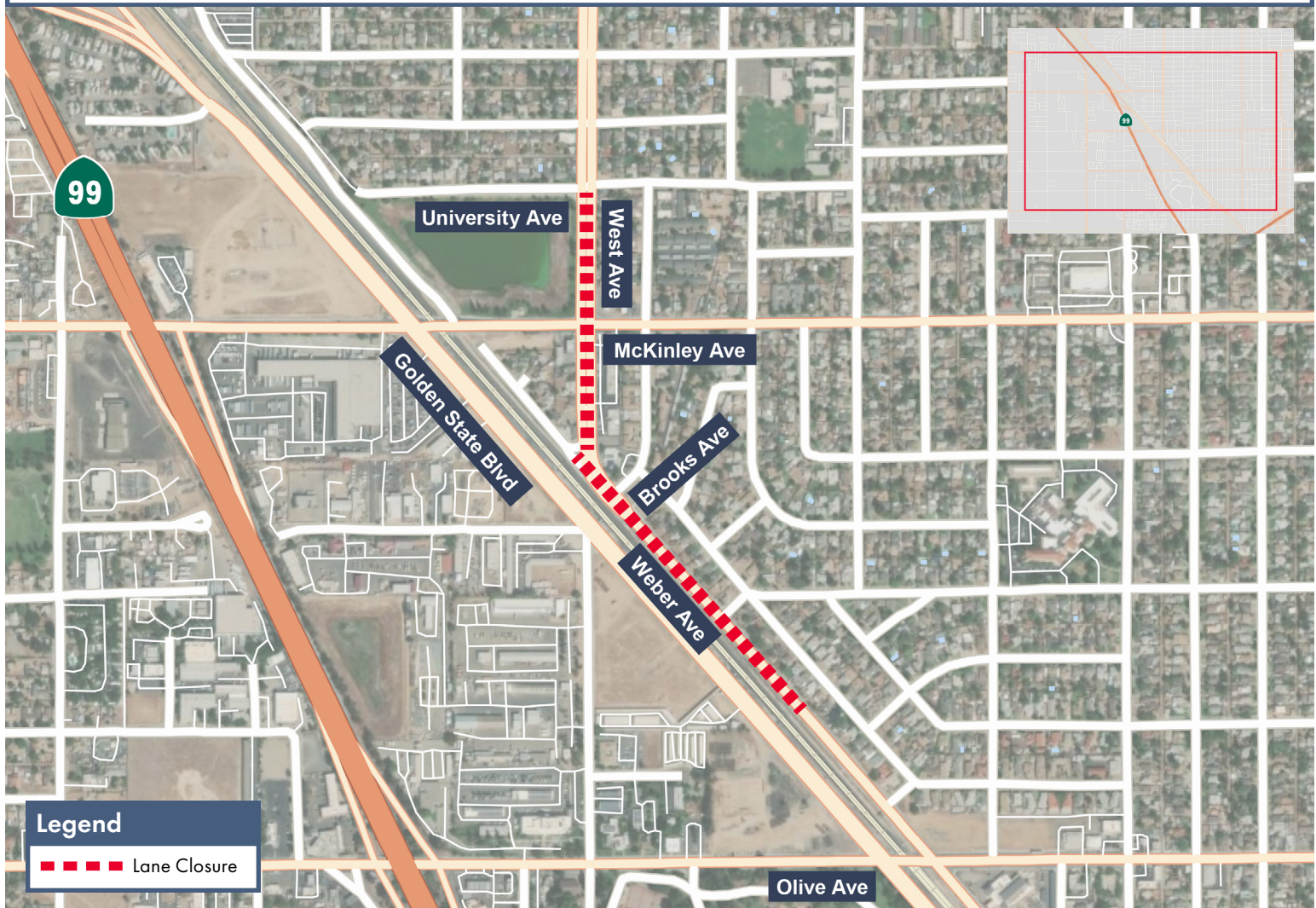
Closure And Detour Information:

Multiple Lane Closures:

- Lane closure along West Avenue between University and Brooks avenues;
- Lane closures along Weber Avenue between Brooks and Olive avenues.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. and will continue through Friday, Jan. 9, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Pedestrian access will be restricted in some areas. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.



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
