



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## Road Closure Extension Along Avenue 120 In Tulare County

**Tulare County, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces a road closure extension along Avenue 120 between State Route (SR) 43 and Road 24 in Tulare County for ongoing work at a high-speed rail structure. Work will continue through October 2026.

**This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.**

### Closure And Detour Information:

Road closure along Avenue 120 between SR 43 and Road 24 in Tulare County for ongoing work at a high-speed rail structure.

**Work will continue through October 2026.**

#### Eastbound Traffic

Traffic going eastbound on Avenue 120 will be detoured north on Road 24, east on Avenue 128, south on SR 43 then east on Avenue 120.

#### Westbound Traffic

Traffic going westbound on Avenue 120 will be detoured north on SR 43, west on Avenue 128, south on Road 24, then west on Avenue 120.

**Drivers should proceed with caution as roadways may be flooded. Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained for all property and business owners.**
