



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Hauling Along Coleman, Cedar, Elkhorn, State Route 41, And Mountain View Avenues In Fresno County

Fresno County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Coleman, Cedar, Elkhorn, State Route (SR) 41, and Mountain View avenues in Fresno County to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled intermittently between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. starting Monday, Dec. 1 through Sunday, Dec. 7, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Materials will be transported west on Coleman Avenue, north on Cedar Avenue, west on Elkhorn Avenue, north on SR 41, then east on Mountain View Avenue to a high-speed rail construction site.
