

CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Road Closure Along Fifth Avenue In Kings County

Kings County, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces a road closure along Fifth Avenue, between Niles and Waukena/Orange avenues in Kings County for ongoing work on a high-speed rail grade separation. Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 9, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:

Road closure along Fifth Avenue, between Niles and Waukena/Orange avenues in Kings County for ongoing work on a high-speed rail grade separation.

Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Tuesday, Dec. 9, 2025.

Northbound Fifth Avenue Detour

Traffic going northbound on Fifth Avenue will be detoured west on Orange Avenue, north on SR 43, north on 5 ½ Avenue, then east on Niles Avenue to Fifth Avenue.

Southbound Fifth Avenue Detour:

Traffic going southbound on Fifth Avenue will be

detoured west on Niles Avenue, south on 5 $\,\%$ Avenue, south on SR 43, then east on Orange Avenue to Fifth Avenue.

Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic. Access will be maintained to all residents and property owners.
