



CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Hauling Along Road 209, State Route 41, 99, 43, And Grangeville Boulevard In Madera, Fresno And Kings Counties

Madera, Fresno, And Kings Counties, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along Road 209, State Route (SR) 41, 99, 43; and Grangeville Boulevard in Madera, Fresno and Kings counties to transport materials to a high-speed rail construction site. Hauling is scheduled from 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. starting Monday, Jan. 5 through Saturday, Jan. 31, 2026.

This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.

Closure And Detour Information:



Materials will be hauled from Road 209 in Madera County, south on SR 41, south on SR 99, south on SR 43, then east on Grangeville Boulevard to a high-speed rail construction site.

Drivers may experience delays. Access will be maintained to all property and business owners in the area.
