## Intermittent Traffic Impacts Along State Route 43 In Fresno County

**Fresno County, Calif.** – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Dragados-Flatiron Joint Venture (DFJV), announces intermittent traffic impacts along State Route (SR) 43, between Davis Avenue and Cole Slough in Fresno County for work on a high-speed rail structure. Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Feb. 2 through Friday, Feb. 6, 2026.

*This work is part of Construction Package 2-3 (CP 2-3), the 65-mile stretch of high-speed rail between East American Avenue in Fresno County and one-mile north of the Tulare-Kern County line.*

### Closure And Detour Information:

Intermittent traffic impacts along SR 43, between Davis Avenue and Cole Slough in Fresno County for work on a high-speed rail structure.

**Work is scheduled from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Monday, Feb. 2 through Friday, Feb. 6, 2026.**

*Signage and flaggers will be in place to direct traffic.*
