Shoulder Closures Along Belmont Avenue In Fresno

Fresno, Calif. – The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority), in cooperation with design-build contractor Tutor-Perini / Zachry / Parsons (TPZP), announces a shoulder closures along Belmont Avenue between Weber and Harrison avenues in Fresno for utility work. Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Wednesday, Dec. 10 through Wednesday, Dec. 24, 2025.

This work is part of Construction Package 1 (CP 1), the first 32-mile stretch of high-speed rail between Avenue 19 in Madera County and East American Avenue in Fresno County.

Closure And Detour Information:

Shoulder closures along Belmont Avenue between Weber and Harrison avenues in Fresno for utility work.

Work is scheduled from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. starting Wednesday, Dec. 10 through Wednesday, Dec. 24, 2025.

Signage will be in place to direct traffic. Access to all businesses and residents will be maintained.



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
